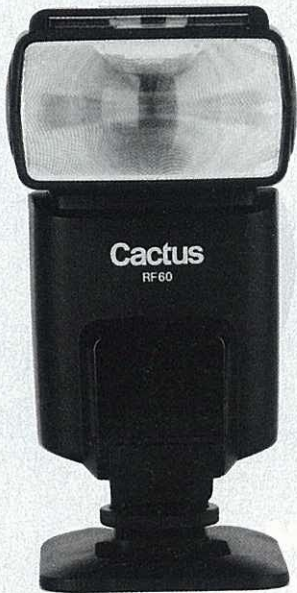

Flash system from Cactus plays nice with the big boys



WIRELESS FLASHES open up a world of lighting opportunities, but products from different brands rarely work well together. Cactus, with lots of competition among third-party flash makers, has made compatibility its calling card. Its new RF60 is a universal hot-shoe flash with a built-in wireless transmitter and receiver that can control up to four groups of other flash units. But the real star may just be the new V6 wireless transceiver, which mounts to any camera with a hot-shoe or PC sync port and can wirelessly fire and control power output from Canon, Nikon, and Pentax flashes—simultaneously.
