Press Release: Cactus Wireless Flash RF60

An all new radio-based wireless portable flash that can remotely control up to 4 flash groups and supports remote power and zoom control. The RF60 works with the upcoming V6 Flash Transceiver as a powerful lighting system.



The Cactus RF60 is a 2.4GHz radio-based wireless portable flash with a built-in transceiver that runs on 16 channels with an output of GN56. Acting as a commander, an RF60 can trigger an unlimited number of RF60 set as receivers and remotely control both flash power and zoom from up to 100m (328 feet).

Meant for use in a multiple flash setup, the RF60 can wirelessly control up to 4 flash groups, and each group can be renamed to one of the pre-set group aliases for easy reference to the particular function of each group right from the RF60 commander unit. The flash also packs an Optical Trigger, which allows users to define the exact flash firing time with the Delay Timer to create the desired lighting effect. Despite being a manual flash, the RF60 can be triggered wirelessly by mounting a TTL flash on camera to do high speed sync flash, supporting shutter speeds up to 1/8000s.

If you prefer to control the RF60 without mounting one on the camera hot shoe, keep an eye for the upcoming Cactus V6, the successor to the widely popular Cactus V5 Wireless Flash Transceiver, available later in Q2 2014. The RF60 Wireless Flash will be available for US\$139.95 (excludes shipping and applicable import duty).
